

## **Join the team of licensed VA health professionals to beat COVID-19!**

Earn eligibility to be a vaccinator in your community!

Did you know that the Virginia Code ( § 54.1-2901- Exceptions and exemptions) allows for a Board of Medicine (BOM) licensee to delegate functions that are non-discretionary and that do not require the exercise of professional judgement to trained individuals?

The provisions of this chapter shall not prevent or prohibit:

-Any practitioner licensed or certified by the Board from delegating to personnel supervised by him, such activities or functions as are nondiscretionary and do not require the exercise of professional judgment for their performance and which are usually or customarily delegated to such persons by practitioners of the healing arts, if such activities or functions are authorized by and performed for such practitioners of the healing arts and responsibility for such activities or functions is assumed by such practitioners of the healing arts.

Based on § 54.1-2901, with appropriate training, you may move forward in being able to administer vaccinations for COVID-19. Please refer to the following link at VDH for training information: [MORE HERE](#)
